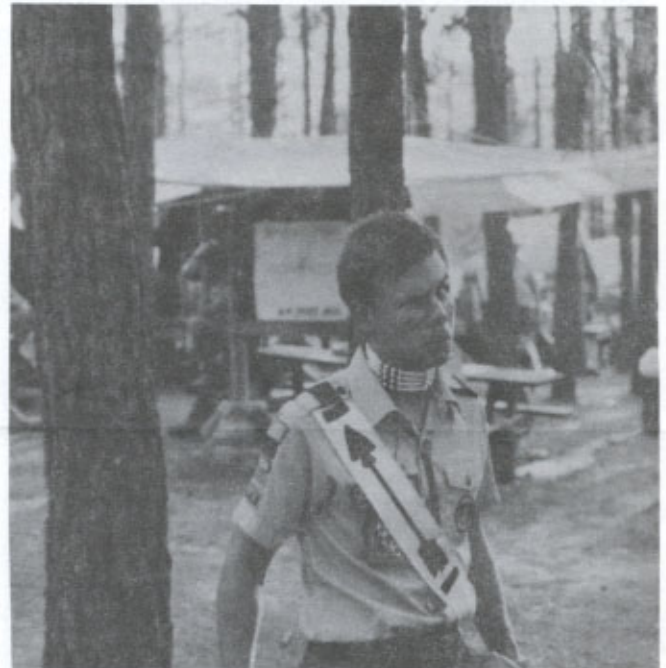

## PERSONAL NOTES

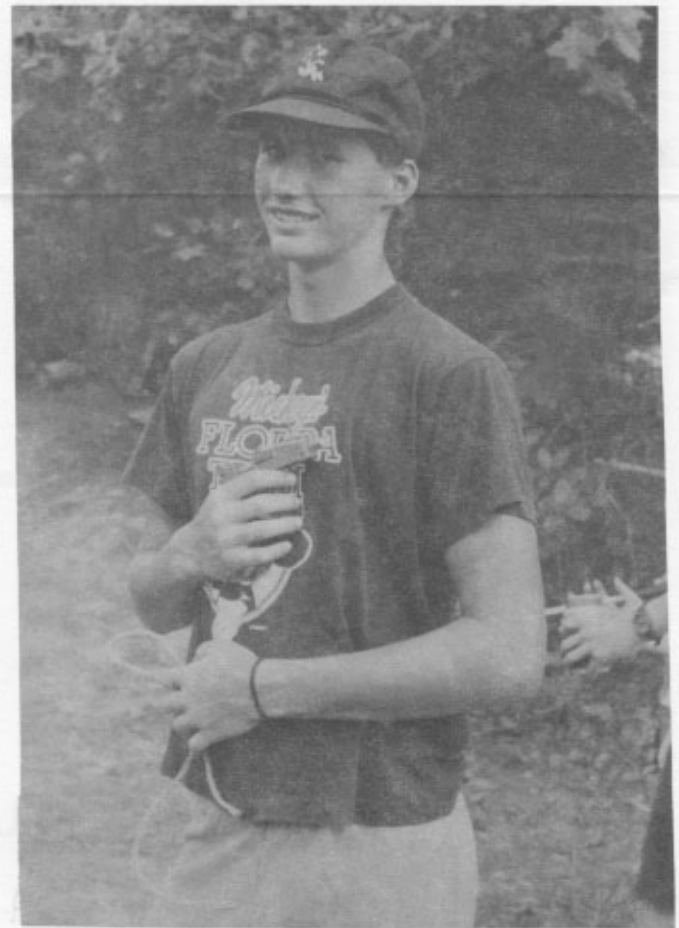

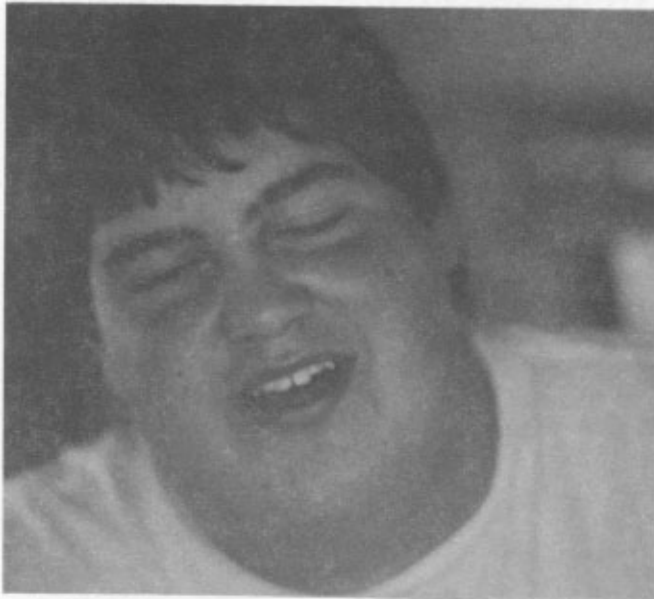
All three of these fine Arrowmen have served Scouting and the Lodge with distinction and we wish them the best!
