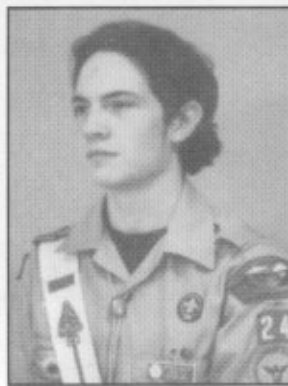


# 1997 LODGE OFFICERS AND ADVISORS

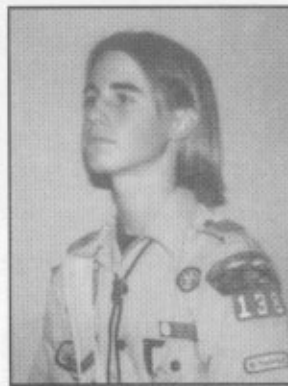
## SECRETARY Patrick Dailey

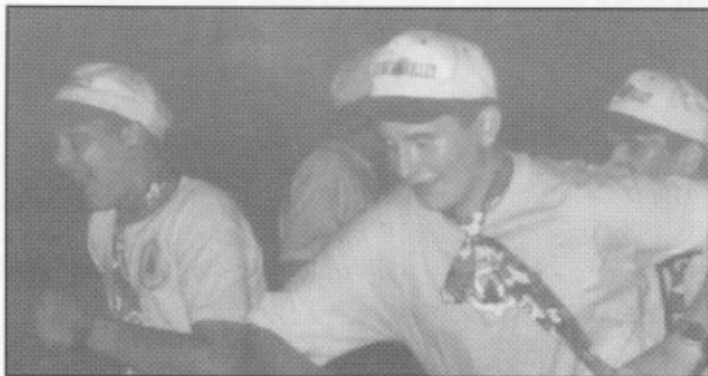
