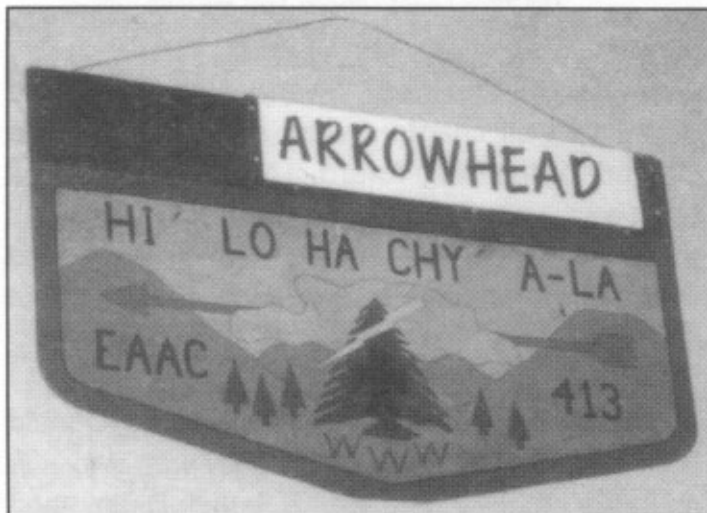
To end it all, everyone circled-up for the song and the lodge candle was extinguished.
